

V200 Body Camera

Let your body camera be your bodyguard.

Questions and answers about the V200 body camera for partners.

Q. What Wi-Fi security protocols does the V200 support?

A. The V200 supports the WPA2-PSK Wi-Fi security protocol.

Q. Does the VB400, V200 and VT100 body cameras offer cloud based and / or on-prem?

A. The VB400, V200, and VT100 work with both cloud and on-prem (coming soon).

Q. Are charging stations available to charge 10 - 20 V200 cameras at the same time?

A. The V200 has an 8 pocket SmartDock.

Q. Is tech training available to program the V200? Is software also needed to program them?

A. VideoManager is the software utilized for assigning cameras to a user for traceability/chain of custody, and also for programming Wi-Fi, profiles, button config, etc.

Q. Is there a PTT button for the GoLive Audio feature?

A. Escalation with GoLive Audio is enabled via the programmable button on the side of the camera.

Q. Can you please provide more details on the Curve interface with the camera?

A. The integration as of today with our VT100 and VB400 body cameras triggers a voice announcement "recording started" from the Curve radio that "security event has begun." This is all done through software integration. This integration is coming soon for the V200 body camera.



Q. Can the VB400 & VT100 connect to the Curve radio like V200 can? Does the V200 need to use the Hub ecosystem?

A. Yes, all of these body cameras use Hub and Avigilon Unity software to connect to Curve through VideoManager.

Q. Do the clips have to be removed to use the smart dock?

A. No, the camera fits in the dock with the clip attached.

Q. Will the V200 be available for VaaS?

A. The V200 camera is CAPEX and VideoManager EX is a subscription. You can repackage the hardware into a lease and refresh the VaaS model.

Q. What are the retention parameters for the EX Cloud?

A. Retention policies are completely customizable. The instance will be set up with defaults, but it is up to the end user on how they want to configure retention.

Q. Can you shut off cloud service per device similar to WAVE software?

A. Yes, you can choose to not renew device subscriptions at the end of the term. However, the license cannot be reassigned to new cameras the way WAVE licenses can be reassigned.

Q. Is there a cost for GoLive? Is it through VMEX or a different platform?

A. It goes through VideoManager EX (mobile app OR browser on computer). As of today, GoLive Audio is built into the VideoManager EX cloud offer.

Q. Is the V200 available with configurable video quality (e.g., 480, 720, 1080) like the VB400?

A. There are two settings inside VideoManager software for V200: standard (480p) and high (720p).

Q. Can you discuss radio pairing?

A. We are working on launching radio pairings later this year, but we do not have committed time frames yet.

Q. Is the V200 body camera NDAA compliant?

A. Yes.

Q. Is the V200 intrinsically safe?

A. No, the V200 is not intrinsically safe.
